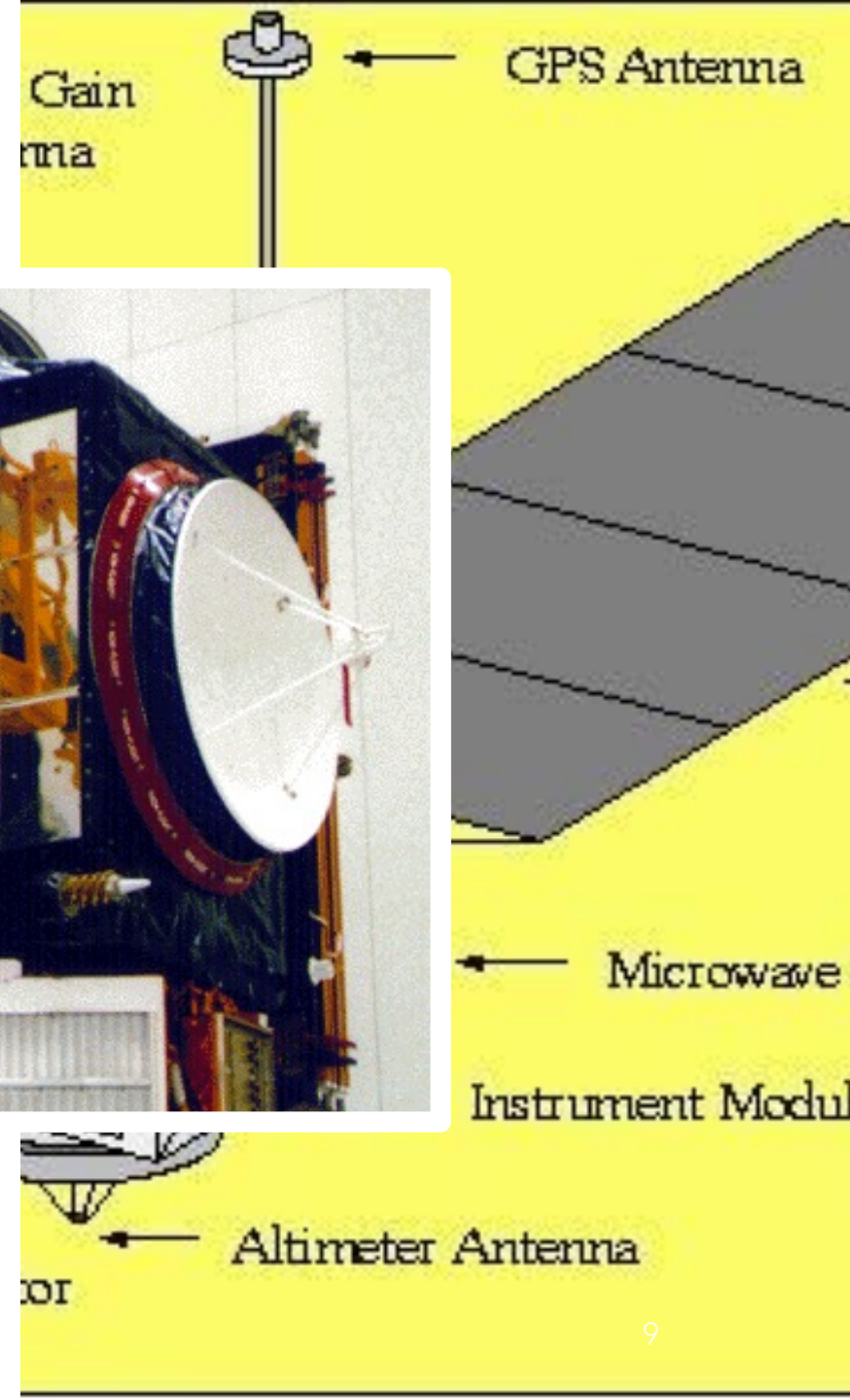
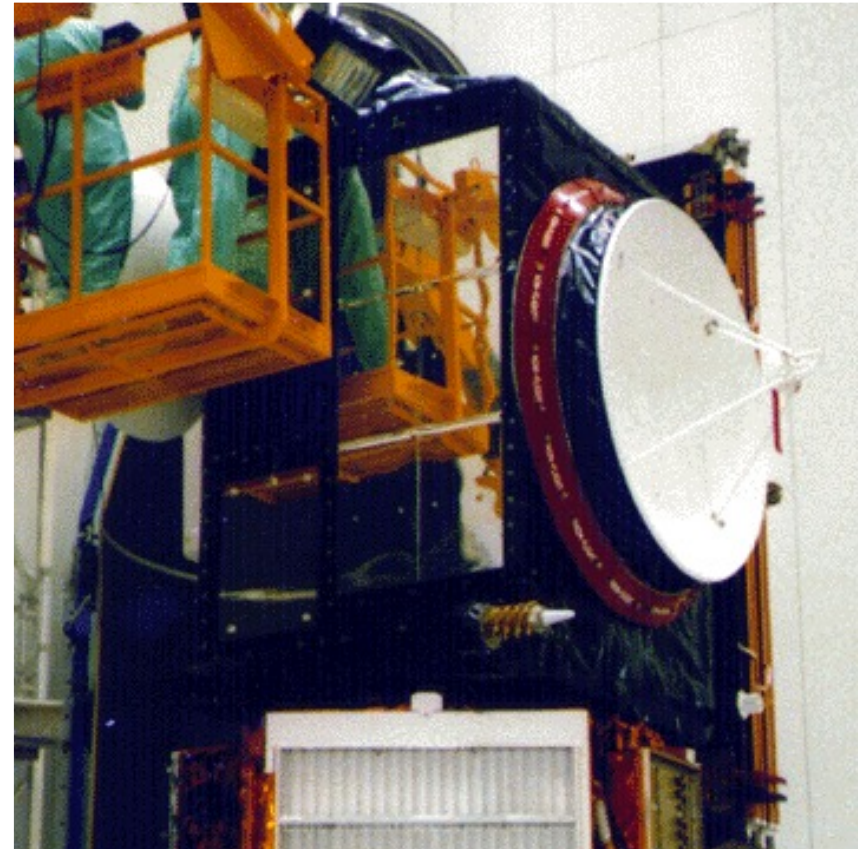
- Could you tell us more about the "black box approach"?
